Beam Me Up!

There's light at the end of the tunnelliterally. Laser treatments are all the rage, and according to several local docs, they can reverse just about every sign of aging. "They have revolutionized the way we treat skin," says dermatologist Paul Friedman of DermSurgery Laser Center, whose book Beautiful Skin Revealed: The Ultimate Guide to Better Skin drops in April. The beauty of the so-called "fractional" laser is that it works on all skin types. Other top Houston surgeons are using the technology, too. Christopher Patronella and Henry Mentz of the Aesthetic Center for Plastic Surgery use a Fraxel laser to smooth wrinkles, scars and stretch marks, while Ermosa Centre for Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery's Christopher Livingston removes tattoos, birthmarks, spider veins and more. Phillip Iero of Bellaire Facial Surgery Center does skin resurfacing with an Ultrapulse carbon dioxide laser as an alternative to chemical peels and dermabrasion. The reason: less pain and downtime. "This is quite an exciting time to be in dermatology," adds Friedman. May the force be with you... –*HC*
